

# **Broxburn Academy Uniform**

Our school uniform is **black and white** and consists of the following:

#### S1-S5

#### S1 – S5

### **Compulsory items**

Plain white shirt or blouse with our Broxburn Academy blue and white striped school tie

(A plain black jumper or cardigan can be worn with the shirt and tie option). or

White polo shirt or Broxburn academy black t- shirt with Black Broxburn academy sweatshirt/ NEW mid-layer/hoodie or zoodie

Plain black bottoms such as trousers, skirt, thick leggings, or joggers - *No logos!* Black, white, or black & white full shoe, ankle boots or trainers.

# S1 – S5 Optional

Pupils in S1-S5 can also opt for a black Broxburn academy school blazer.

# Summer uniform S1-S6

# Our young people have asked for shorts to be added to our uniform.

We have listened and have agreed with young people that plain black (no logos) knee length shorts can be worn in the summer months from **April to June** and from **August to September**.

To mitigate against our concerns regarding shorts being worn in practical subjects e.g. Science/Food technology /Practical woodwork/ Craft and Design Technology (CDT) the shorts should be **plain black, knee length and loose fitting.**

#### What is not part of our school uniform

- Any item which displays markings or a brand other than the school logo.
- Belts which are not plain black or with for example logos or adornments.
- Ripped or netted tights
- Ripped or studded jeans/trousers/shorts/skirts
- Football or other sports shirts/tops.

# **Physical Education**

T-shirt or plain sports shirt – No football or other sport colours Black leggings, joggers, or shorts Trainers (note if these are not black/white they should be carried and changed in to at PE)

Classes involved in swimming throughout the year can bring any swimming costume/trunks they have and are welcome to wear leggings, shorts, or t-shirts on top.

Please wherever possible ensure that all items of clothing are clearly labelled, particularly ties, sweatshirts and blazers which are often lost.

# For young people who have PE in period 7 (Mon –Thurs) or period 4 (Friday) there is no requirement to change back into uniform at end of school day.
